

Vintage & Vinification Notes

2019 was a cool and "classic" Willamette Valley vintage. Moderately cool temperatures were the common theme throughout the growing season; extending the start of harvest into late September. Bright and sunny days with cool dry nights were observed the latter half of September and into October giving the grapes the final push to perfect ripeness. Fermented and aged entirely in stainless steel tanks to maintain the brightness and crisp acidity, this 2019 edition of Pinot Gris captures the beauty, magic and adventure found in an Oregon summer.
