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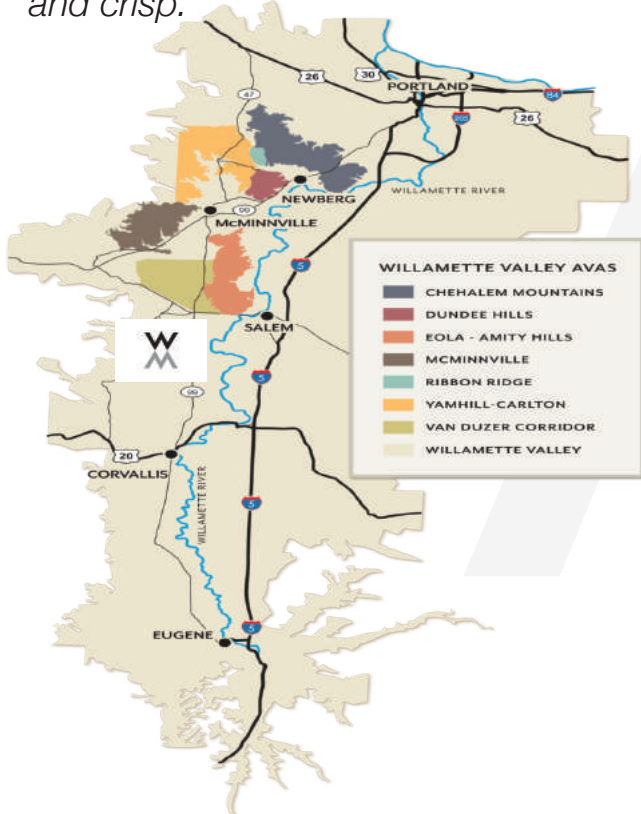

Winemaker's Tasting Notes

“Aromas of strawberries, orange blossom, fresh tarragon. The palate is bright and fresh with notes of raspberry, tangerine, minerality. A classic Willamette Valley Pinot Noir Rosé; fresh, vibrant and crisp.”



Vintage & Vinification Notes

2019 was a cool and “classic” Willamette Valley vintage. Moderately cool temperatures were the common theme throughout the growing season; extending the start of harvest into late September. Bright and sunny days with cool dry nights were observed the latter half of September and into October giving the grapes the final push to perfect ripeness. Soaked on the skins for 12 hours to draw out the beautiful Rosé color, the wine is then pressed and racked to small stainless steel vessels for a long and relatively cool fermentation before bottling. This 2019 edition of Pinot Noir Rosé captures the beauty and essence of a true Oregon summer.
